Notice is hereby given that Exeter City Council proposes to make the above mentioned amendment Order under Section 35 and Part IV of Schedule 9 and Schedule 10 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers.

- b) To reclassify the Bampfylde Street, Bartholomew Terrace, Harlequins, Matthews Hall Topsham, Princesshay 3 (Broadwalk House), Smythen Street, Topsham Quay, Princesshay 2 (Civic Centre), Magdalen Street, King William Street/Leighton Terrace, Magdalen Road (Fairpark), Howell Road and Parr Street Car Parks as "Tariff Band 2: Short Stay Shoppers' Car Parks" and to remove the provision of Quarterly Season Tickets in respect of Magdalen Road, Howell Road and Parr Street Car Parks:
- c) To introduce new lengths of stay and increased tariffs at the Magdalen Road, Howell Road and Parr Street Car Parks as follows:-
